Bradford County Facts

- Since its beginning, the Bradford County Agricultural Land Preservation Program has allocated over \$4 million dollars protecting farmland and the future of our counties agricultural heritage.
- Bradford County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program and Board were established by the County Commissioners in 2001.
- As of 2021, 19 farms have been protected, totaling over 4,661 acres.
- There are a total of 33 Agricultural Security Areas (ASA) located within Bradford County.
- The Agricultural Conservation Easement Program was developed in 1988 under an amendment to the ASA Law, Act 43 of 1981. This program is currently funded by a 2 cent tax per pack of cigarettes sold in the state, which annually generates approximately \$20 million.
